Separate sealed bids will be received for the Highway Sewer Crossing Retrofit.

A conditional or qualified bid will not be accepted if it modifies the Plans or Specifications or method of work.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held to familiarize potential bidders with the project and is scheduled for 1:30 p.m., July 22nd, 2026, at the McKinleyville Community Services District Office, 1656 Sutter Road, McKinleyville, California.

The work for this project generally includes, but is not limited to, furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, and supervision required for the installation of two steel encased sewer mains crossing the US-101 via Horizontal Auger Boring (HAB) comprised of one 18-inch PVC or HDPE sewer main within a steel casing and one 12-inch PVC or HDPE sewer main within a steel casing and associated work including sewer manholes, 10-inch to 18-inch PVC sewer mains installed via open trench, connections to existing sewer mains and manholes, coating and rechanneling of existing manholes, paving and site restoration, and other items of work as shown on the Plans. Temporary bypass pumping will be required to maintain flows during construction. Settlement monitoring will be required for each highway crossing.

Contractors shall submit Qualifications Statements as a part of their bid that meet the requirements outlined in the following sections of the Contract Documents: Section 1.7.A of Specification 31 09 13 (Geotechnical Instrumentation and Monitoring), Section 1.6.A of Specification Section 33 05 07.22 (Horizontal Auger Boring), and Section 1.7.A of Specification 33 05 07.23 (Carrier Pipe Installation).

Bids will be received by the General Manager of the McKinleyville Community Services District at the District office, 1656 Sutter Road, McKinleyville, California, 95519 until August 21st, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed to the General Manager at McKinleyville Community Services District, PO Box 2037, McKinleyville, CA 95519 and must be delivered to the District office by the above referenced time and date.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond in an amount of not less than 10 percent of the bid amount. Successful bidders will be required to

furnish a Payment Bond, Warranty Bond, and Performance Bond in the full amount of the Contract Price upon receipt of the Notice of Award. In accordance with Public Contract Code Section 10263, the Contractor will be allowed to substitute securities for monies normally withheld by the Owner to insure performance under this contract.

California State prevailing wage rates will be required on this project. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California. The general prevailing wage rates applicable to the work are set by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations.

The District requires that all contractors and subcontractors working on this project keep certified payroll records in accordance with Labor Code 1776 and submit copies to the District. All contractors and subcontractors must also furnish electronic certified payroll records directly to the Labor Commissioner (Division of Labor Standards Enforcement).

It shall be mandatory upon the contractor herein and upon any subcontractors to pay not less than the said specified rates to all laborers, workers and mechanics employed by them in the execution of the Agreement pursuant to CA Labor Code 1774. The Contractor will be required to comply with any changes in these wage rates as they are updated by the State government at no cost to the Owner.

Attention is directed to the provisions in section 1777.5 and sections 1777.6 of the Labor Code concerning the requirement to employ apprentices by the contractor or any subcontractor under it.

Pursuant to Senate Bill 854, all contractors bidding on public works projects must register with the Department of Industrial Relations. Contractors are subject to a registration and annual renewal fee. No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)]. Accordingly, all Prime and Subcontractors contained in the bid must provide valid Department of Industrial Relations registration number(s). Failure to provide valid DIR registration numbers in the bidding documents shall disqualify the bid.
